BERRY SPRING GARDEN FESTIVAL

17TH - 19TH OCTOBER 2019

Berry is a delightful village nestled between rolling green hills with the spectacular Cambewarra Range on one side and a stunning coastline on the other. Each spring the 'town of trees' is transformed by a mass of colour and many of the beautiful private gardens are open to visitors. The festival raises money for a variety of charities, last year's festival included 8 gardens in and around Berry and this year promises to be just as successful.

Another of the highlights will be our visit to Bundanon, Arthur and Yvonne Boyd's gift to the Nation. The bequest includes several thousand acres of lush Shoalhaven River frontage along with the amazing art collection. The gift was borne out of Arthur Boyd's often stated view that "*you can't own a landscape*" and the deeply felt wish that others may draw inspiration from Bundanon. The Bundanon Trust, in addition to caring for a collection of more than 4,000 art works, supports the development of arts practice across all disciplines through its artist in residence program and secondary school's courses.

Our 3 day tour will allow a relaxed pace to enjoy both the Festival and the many attractions of the Illawarra and Shoalhaven Coasts and the Southern Highlands. Our journey down will take us through Kangaroo Valley and we will return on the Coast Road and the Princes Highway. Our accommodation for this tour is at the Kiama Shores Motel (Ph: 4233 1100), a perfect base to explore the south coast.
