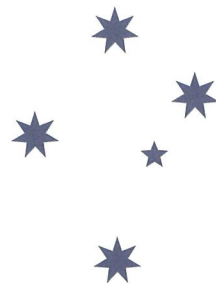

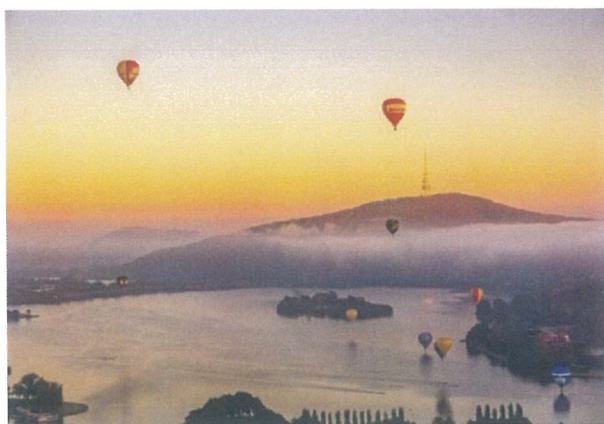


CANBERRA LOVE & DESIRE EXHIBITION & BALLOON FESTIVAL

3 DAY TOUR

10TH – 12^H MARCH 2019

This tour combines 3 of our capital's major events for 2019- The Tate Love & Desire Exhibition, The Balloon Festival and Enlighten. The Tate Gallery's masterpieces are rarely lent, most have never been seen in Australia before and the exhibition represents a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity. The exhibition features 40 of the Tate's most famous and best-loved works, alongside 40 paintings from other British and Australian collections. The Pre-Raphaelites drew inspiration from the great love stories of history and literature, the tempestuousness of lustful entanglements, and the wonder of religious icons.



The Canberra Balloon Spectacular is rated one of the top 4 ballooning events in the world and in 2019 the festival celebrates its 33rd year. Our beautiful capital provides a wonderful backdrop as pilots from all over the world bring their balloons of amazing shapes and colour to the lawns of Old Parliament House.

During the 10 nights of Enlighten, architectural projections will transform the beautiful buildings of the parliament triangle, bring vibrant colour movement and celebration to 6 cultural institutions at the heart of our capital. The walls of Parliament House, Old Parliament House, The National Library, Questacon, The National Portrait Gallery and The National Gallery of Australia will provide a gallery of the grandest proportions.
