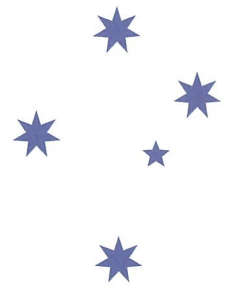

*7 DAY TOUR*

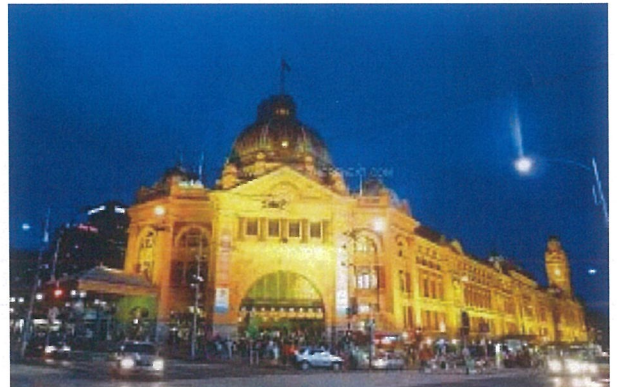

Our journey from Melbourne to Albury will see us travel over the Yarra Ranges through Marysville which was at the centre of the devastating Black Saturday Bushfires of 2009. We will also take in Mansfield and the outstanding Benalla Botanic gardens and Regional Gallery. Our final night is in Wagga, we will travel along the Olympic Way through Culcairn and Henty. Our return to Sydney is through Junee and Cootamundra, returning to the Hume Highway at Junee.
