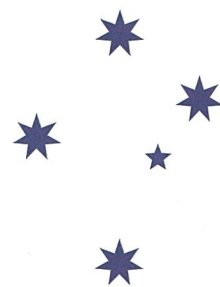

Orange is Australia's colour city offering a diverse range of wonderful attractions, four very contrasting seasons ensure your visit will be a little different each time. Canobolas, an extinct volcano, towers over Orange and the Cabonne country surveying its legacy of fertility. The area has a fine reputation as a food bowl with grain fed beef, fat lambs, grapes, apples, cherries, stone fruit, berries, nuts and vegetables all produced in abundance. Orange today is a sophisticated and prosperous city with a history dating back to the very first gold rush and many fine heritage buildings.

Andrew Barton (Banjo) Paterson was an Australian legend recognised as one of Australia's most famous and admired bush poets. He wrote ballads and poems about Australian life, focusing particularly on the rural and outback areas, including districts in NSW where he spent much of his childhood. He led a fascinating life and went on to become a journalist, lawyer, farmer and war correspondent, who served in WW1. His most famous work is *Waltzing Matilda* which is known worldwide but many Australians can recite a string of his poems and some of his work has been converted to song and theatre.
